CONCEPT

LOCATION

The Barefoot is located within an almost pristine forest, on the local island of Hanimaadhoo, in the preserved deep North of the Maldives. This 4 star Eco Hotel is well connected to Malé International airport by numerous daily 45 minute flights. The dense vegetation allows not only privacy but the opportunity to experience untouched nature and the genuine, natural Maldives along with all the amenities expected from a charming accommodation option. A private, half mile sandy beach and a turquoise lagoon frame the hotel, inviting guests to experience an authentic and relaxing holiday at outstanding value.

ACCOMMODATION

Total of 64 rooms. 40 high standard and fully furnished rooms, in two storey building of 4 rooms each:

20 Beach Front rooms On the ground floor, with direct access to the white sandy beach. Large sized rooms (about 50 sqm including the veranda), double or twin beds.

20 Ocean View rooms Upper floor with a spectacular sea view. Large sized rooms (about 50 sqm including the terrace), double or twin beds. Each room is spacious, creatively designed and comfortable, with an elegant, natural stone en-suite bathroom and shower.

Family rooms (2 connecting beach front or ocean view rooms) are also available. Maximum occupancy 6 people.

12 Beachside rooms These new charming rooms are furnished with elegant materials and contemporary amenities, including a spacious private patio equipped with a Maldivian swing. They are just beside our endless white beach, with lateral sea view.

12 Seaside rooms Affordable and comfortable accommodation (44 sqm including the veranda), nicely furnished with a modern and elegant double sink bathroom. They are part of the same complex with a sandy inner courtyard, just few steps away from the beach.

After great work and commitment, in 2021 The Barefoot Eco Hotel was certified as a GSTC sustainable hotel. The GSTC certification promotes the increased knowledge, understanding and adoption of sustainable tourism practices.



All our marine excursions have been designed and developed to reduce the impact on the environment on one side, and on the other to contribute to the monitoring of biodiversity and the economy of the local community. Particularly, during the turtle, manta ray and dolphin monitoring excursions, guests will have the opportunity to be actively involved in the collection of data to help the marine biologist's job in the monitoring process of the population distribution of these animals.

Beach Clean Ups: the marine biologist alongside with the diving center organise clean-up days to protect the beach and surrounding systems. In doing so, we can keep the environment clean and most importantly, we promote awareness to our guests about ocean pollution.

Evening Presentations: we offer marine biology talks, three times a week, covering topics from rays to sharks, turtles and dolphins, fish identification, coral reefs and plastic pollution. Moreover, marine themed documentaries and diving videos are played during the week after dinner.

The mission of The Barefoot Eco Hotel is not only to preserve the marine environments but also to conserve the above sea level habitat. The hotel offers **cultural and environmental bike tours** in the local village, for a peek into the authentic Maldivian lifestyle. We also organise guided trips to **Utheemu Island**, to visit the Palace of the Sultan Mohammad Thakurufaaru and to learn about his importance in Maldivian history.

Each class has a duration of 45 minutes (introduction – breathing practice – warm up – standing and seating sequence – meditation). It is designed for everyone who wishes to escape the daily routine, stress and worries of modern day life.

THE BAREFOOT DIVING CENTER

Our diving center guarantees the highest level of quality and professionalism and offers complete sets of rental equipment (on charge) including BCD, masks, snorkels, fins, wetsuits, dive computers as well as customised services, suitable for both adults and children. All levels of PADI and SSI courses are available, including "NITROX" or "ENRICHED AIR DIVER" and free "TRY DIVES". The water is azure blue, warm and the variety of dive sites are stunning (20-30 at a boat distance of 40 minutes). All the areas are unique and renowned for their abundance of big aquatic animals such as sharks and manta rays, together with a great diversity of hard and soft corals and fish of all size and colour.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Spoken languages: English, Italian, German, French, Hindi and Divehi.

Credit cards: Visa, MasterCard can be used to pay all extras. USD is the currency of the resort.

Voltage: 220 volts, plus 110 volts socket in the bathrooms.

Climate: In the Maldives there are two main seasons: from December to May it is sunny and fairly dry, while from June to November there are occasional brief rain showers followed by sunshine. Year round, temperatures range from 25 to 35°C, and the average humidity level is around 70%.

Clothing: Practical and informal summer clothes. Don't forget a sun hat, sunglasses and sunscreen. Dress code: both in the daytime and in the evening, it is not permitted to enter the bars and restaurants in bathing suits or with wet clothes; guests are requested to always wear at least a T-shirt in these areas. In the evenings and after dinner, shorts and wraparound skirts are allowed. Guests are more than welcome to go barefoot anywhere in the hotel. Nudity and topless sunbathing are strictly forbidden.

Hanimaadhoo Island: Hanimaadhoo is located in the North of Maldives and it is one of the most beautiful islands in the country, with lush vegetation, long beaches and a turquoise lagoon. It opens the door to an adventurous and genuine gateway, where tourists can be spoiled with true Maldivian warm hospitality. Hanimaadhoo is a quiet fishing village with lots of tree-shade and swings. Fishing and agriculture is what most of the 2500 inhabitants of the island do for work. Hanimaadhoo community services: school, mosque, health center, climate observatory, local village, police station, airport.
